

- Property is needed to construct a Regional Flood Control (Pond PR-2) Storm Water Impoundment in Cottonwood Creek as identified and obligated with the IGA with Pueblo County
- Owner has agreed to donate property.
- No Environmental Constraints
- Pond PR-2 will provide Flood Control in Cottonwood
 Creek for a 6 square mile watershed (85% Developed).
- Pond PR-2 will provide 12 % flow reduction for 100-year return storm.
- Reconstruction of existing channel and construction of drop structure will reduce bank and bed erosion.




