




- Preliminary 2019 OATT Filing to OCA (provided as agreed on 2/22/19)
- Request to establish a Public Hearing date and formal filing of the 2019 OATT Filing with City Clerk
- Formal filing electronically provided to City Council
- Filing documents posted on CSU.org website
- Published Legal Notice in the Gazette
- Confirmed that the Office of the City Auditor has reviewed the filing and has no comments
- 2019 Rate Case Hearing

Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) Changes

- OATT governs wholesale high voltage electric transmission service
- Our OATT customers were informed of the proposed changes and have no concerns
- Adopting these tariff changes satisfies a condition to participate in the Joint Dispatch Agreement

Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) Changes

- Tariff changes set forth the terms, conditions and eligibility requirements of Joint Dispatch Transmission Service
 - Signatory to a Joint Dispatch Agreement
 - Adoption of a zero dollar rate for the delivery and receipt of qualifying energy
 - Mandate that the zero dollar rate is reciprocal among the participating utilities
- Proposed tariff sheet effective date: May 1, 2019
