




#### **Sterling Ranch Background**

- Located outside of the City
  - ~5,800 single family equivalents (SFEs) at build out
  - 287 platted lots
- City Administration has determined that the development should be annexed into the City and is in talks with property owners
- Developers desire interim wastewater service for the 287 platted lots while annexation discussions proceed
- Utilities is willing to and can provide interim wastewater service for the 287 pending annexation

#### **Ability to Serve**

- Up to 700 lots could be served without impacts to Utilities' wastewater treatment system
- Collection system improvements necessary to serve additional lots
- No impact on Utilities' ability to provide wastewater services for current or future inside City customers
- Utilities has the capacity to provide electric, water, wastewater, and gas services upon annexation

#### **Key Agreement Terms**

- Short term special contract for wastewater service with Sterling Ranch Metropolitan District for 287 lots for one year, with renewal options
- District will be required to cause owners of property within the Sterling Ranch Master Plan area to submit petition for annexation in a form acceptable to the City within 90 days of connecting to Utilities' wastewater system
- District to pay outside City development charge for 3" connection and pay outside City special contract rates for wastewater
- Compliance with applicable City/Utilities' resolutions, codes, ordinances, regulations and policies related to annexation and utility service
- Construction of all public improvements in accordance with City standards and requirements for public improvements built after execution of special contract

#### **Mutually Beneficial Contract**

- Sterling Ranch receives one year of wastewater service
- Sterling Ranch to pay for all necessary infrastructure
- Utilities collects wastewater treatment revenue
