


- New metropolitan district to support proposed 427 dwelling unit residential development on former Nazarene Bible College site- 42 acres
- 30 mills debt service (retroactively Gallagher adjusted)
- 15 mills operations- also Gallagher-adjusted
 Higher than Special District Policy
- \$ 20,000,000 maximum allowable debt
- Operations and maintenance functions:
 - Covenant enforcement
 - Streetscaping, public art, parks and recreation

Vicinity Map








Pending Development Plan

 Section 7. In the event the property to be served by the District has not been rezoned to substantially allow for the residential land uses contemplated by this Service Plan, on or before December 31, 2020, the District shall either initiate dissolution of the District or petition for an amended service plan.
