Summary



- Amended and restated metropolitan district service plan bringing Sands Metro. District Nos. 1-3 under City model service plan.
- Contemplated by 2018 IGA between City and Districts executed at time of annexation
- Creates an additional district (No. 5) to include another property owned by petitioner
- Sands District No. 4 (not in City) would remain under 2016
 County service plan- for now
- Debt service mill levy cap of 40.0 mills (Gallagher-adjusted) for District Nos. 1and 2 (based on IGA)
 - District No. 5 debt service cap would be 30.0 mills (Gallagher-adjusted)

Summary- Continued




- District No. 3 (commercial district) would have a debt service mill levy cap of 50.0 mills, consistent with Policy
- O&M mill levy cap of 10.0 Mills for all districts- Gallagheradjusted
- Combined maximum authorized debt of \$28,540,103
- O&M functions could include:
 - Common area maintenance
 - Covenant enforcement
 - Parks and recreation

- Sands Addition Annexation 1-4 approved in the 2018
- 2018 IGA between City and Sands Metropolitan Districts 1-3 requires conversion to the City model within 3 years

Existing District Boundaries OLORADO SPRINGS OLYMPIC CITY USA




District 5 Parcel

Contingency Condition



• Section 3. *In the event the property to be* served by the District No. 5 has not been rezoned to substantially allow for the residential land uses contemplated by this Service Plan, on or before December 31, 2020, the Districts shall petition for an amended service plan to either remove District No. 5 from the consolidated service plan or to otherwise modify the plan to reflect and accommodate the allowable uses on this site.


