


Background

- 2002-2004 Extreme drought conditions and watering restrictions
- 2003-2004 City Council approved the purchase of the Jimmy Camp Creek Parcels to ensure addition water storage
 - 15 properties purchased
 - 400 plus acres
- 2009 Preferred Alternative for Southern Delivery System Project was determined to be the Upper Williams Creek Reservoir
- 2016 Southern Delivery System Phase 1 completed
- 2017 Site removed from Water Resource Plan
- 2019 Request to implement Rights of First Refusal/Intra-City Transfer




Rights of First Refusal/Intra-City Transfer

- Internal team City Attorney's Office, City Auditors Office, City Real Estate Services, Work Force Communications, Parks and Utilities staff
- TRS Assist with relocation, moving, and communication with tenants
- Inspections on each home
- Appraisals completed to determine fair market value
- Communication to tenants and former property owners



First Right of Refusal -Exercised

• Four former property owners have exercised their rights of first refusal
