AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY DESCRIBED AS WEST MORENO AVENUE BETWEEN SOUTH SIERRA MADRE STREET AND SAHWATCH STREET AS WELL AS A 30-FOOT WIDE PORTION OF SAHWATCH STREET BETWEEN WEST CIMARRON STREET AND WEST MORENO AVENUE WITHIN ADDITION #1 TO THE TOWN OF COLORADO SPRINGS CONSISTING OF 0.87 OF AN ACRE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. City Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to vacate and hereby vacates portions of a public right-of-way described as West Moreno Avenue between South Sierra Madre Street and Sahwatch Street as well as a 30-foot wide portion of Sahwatch Street between West Cimarron Street and West Moreno Avenue within Addition #1 to the Town of Colorado Springs consisting of 0.87 of an acre, as described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof subject to the reservations of easement set forth in Section 2, below.

Section 2. Council accepts and reserves from this vacation public utility easements over, under and through the vacated portion of right-of-way described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, subject to those terms and conditions as set forth in that certain instrument filed in the public records of El Paso County, Colorado at Reception No. 212112548, except Dual Easements as defined by City Code section 7.7.607.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by Charter.
