ORDINANCE NO. 19-____

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY DESCRIBED AS THE NORTH/SOUTH RUNNING PUBLIC ALLEY THAT CONNECTS EAST CACHE LA POUDRE STREET AND EAST DALE STREET BETWEEN NORTH TEJON STREET AND NORTH NEVADA AVENUE WITHIN THE TOWN OF COLORADO SPRINGS ADDITION NO. 1 SUBDIVISION PLAT CONSISTING OF 7,998 SQUARE FEET

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. City Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to vacate and hereby vacates portions of a public right-of-way described as the north/south running public alley that connects East Cache la Poudre Street and East Dale Street between North Tejon Street and North Nevada Avenue within the Town of Colorado Springs Addition No. 1 subdivision plat consisting of 7,998 square feet, as described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, subject to the reservations of easement set forth in Section 2 below.

Section 2. Council excepts and reserves from this vacation public utility easements over, under and through the vacated portions of rights-of-way described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, subject to those terms and conditions as set forth in that certain instrument filed in the public records of El Paso County, Colorado at Reception No. 212112548.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by Charter.

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Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the Office of the City Clerk.
