## ORDINANCE NO. 19-94

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18-118 (2019 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE LODGERS & AUTO RENTAL TAX (LART) FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$154,652 FOR THREE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS AND EVENTS RECOMMENDED BY THE LART CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1.
