AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 19-87 (2020 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE HUMANE SOCIETY LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SHELTERING CONTRACT

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 19-87 is hereby amended by increasing the expenditure appropriation of the General Fund in the amount of \$100,000 for the Humane Society animal law enforcement and sheltering contract. The source of funds is the General Fund available fund balance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
