ISSUES FOR DECISION 2021 RATE CASE HEARING OCTOBER 27, 2020

Natural Gas Service:

- 1. Is an increase to the Natural Gas Revenues of approximately \$2.4 million appropriate for the 2021 rate case test-year period?
- 2. Should rates and tariffs for the following Natural Gas Service Rate Schedules be revised as proposed:
 - a. Residential Service Firm (G1R);
 - b. Commercial Service Small Firm (G1CS);
 - c. Commercial Service Large Firm (G1CL, G8M, G1S);
 - d. Industrial Service Interruptible (G2I, G3M);
 - e. Industrial Transportation Service Firm (G4T);
 - f. Contract Service Military Firm (GCS-FIRM, GCS-G6M); and
 - g. Contract Service Military Interruptible (GCS-INTS, GCS-G7M)?
- 3. Should Utilities increase the summer usage requirement for the Contract Service – Large Firm Seasonal Option (G1S) from 30% to 37%?
- Should Utilities remove an obsolete reference to capacity releases on the Colorado Interstate Gas Company system in the Contract Service – Military Firm (GCS-FIRM, GCS-G6M) tariff?
- 5. Should Utilities modify the Natural Gas rate schedules to remove the term "sales" from Interruptible Services as an administrative clean-up?
- 6. Should Utilities modify the General section and the Commercial Service – Large Firm Options (G8M, G1S) to clarify when a separate contract is required to receive service under various rate options?

Electric Service:

- 1. Should Utilities modify rate table as proposed for the following rates:
 - a. Residential Service Time-of-Day Option (ETR);
 - b. Commercial Service General Time-of-Day Option (ETC);
 - c. Small Power Producer and Cogeneration Service?
- 2. Should Utilities modify the General section and the Industrial Service – Time-of-Day 1,000 kWh/Day Minimum rate options to clarify when a separate contract is required to receive service under various rate options?
- 3. Should Utilities modify the Renewable Energy Net Metering tariff with three (3) changes as proposed?

Water Service:

1. Should Utilities modify the Augmentation (W1G) water rate schedule as proposed?

Wastewater Service:

1. Should Utilities modify the Contract Service – Outside City Limits (S9C) rate schedule through implementation the second annual rate increase of a three year rate increase phase in?
