AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 115 (AUTOMATED VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM (AVIS)) OF PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS) OF ARTICLE 1 (ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT) OF CHAPTER 10 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO AVIS PROCEDURES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 115 (Automated Vehicle Identification System (AVIS))

of Part 1 (General Provisions) of Article 1 (Administration and Enforcement) of

Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado

Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

10.1.115: AUTOMATED VEHICLE IDENTIFICIATON SYSTEM (AVIS)

B. Procedure, Issuance of Penalty Assessment Notice Or Summons And Complaint:

1. When a police peace officer, based on evidence obtained in whole or in part by means of an AVIS has probable cause to believe that a vehicle has been driven in violation of subsection 10.5.104F, "Exceeding Posted Speed Limit: AVIS Violations" or 10.17.105C5, "Traffic Control Signal Legend: AVIS Violations", of this chapter, the police peace officer may issue, or cause to be issued, a penalty assessment notice to the person in whose name the vehicle is registered, based on the license plate or any other identification of the vehicle, with a violation of the applicable section. If, however, the vehicle is registered in more than one person's name, the penalty assessment notice may be issued to the registrant whom the issuing police peace officer determines, under all the facts and circumstances, was the person most likely depicted in the image produced by the camera.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.
