AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20-92 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) (2021 FOR Α SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE LODGERS & AUTO RENTAL TAX (LART) FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,309,315 FOR ADDITIONAL PROJECTS AND EVENTS RECOMMENDED BY THE LART CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 20-92 is hereby amended by increasing the expenditure appropriation of the Lodgers & Auto Rental Tax (LART) Fund in the amount of \$1,309,315 for additional 2021 LART projects and events, as shown in the attached Exhibit A. The source of funds is the LART available fund balance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
