**Summary:**

During 2016, as part of the citywide “code scrub” effort to review City Code for necessary updates, members of City Council and representatives of the executive branch convened working committee to review the provisions of Chapter 1 (Administration) and certain provisions of other chapters that are administrative in nature. As a result of that review, the group recommends a number of changes to certain administrative provisions of City Code.

This ordinance amends Section 1.2.407 of Chapter 1 relating to reports to Council, specifying that the City Attorney’s reports shall be submitted quarterly, and that they should be delivered to the City’s Risk Manager in addition to the Mayor and City Council.
