A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Transfer Funds in the General Fund from the Public Works Department to the Planning/Economic Development /Housing Department

Summary:

We are seeking Council approval to move budget and appropriation authority within the General Fund from the Public Works Department to Planning Department in the amount of \$1,058,725. Pursuant to City Code 1.5.105, City Council may authorize the Mayor to transfer funds from one group or department to another within the same fund by resolution. This will facilitate the transfer of the development review functions that are currently budgeted in Public Works/City Engineering over to the Planning Department.
