Summary:

As discussed in the preceding Public Hearing, the attached resolution is presented for approval by City Council, sitting as the Board of Directors of the Colorado Springs Cottonwood General Improvement District (GID), to appropriate the funding for the 2015 budget year.

Previous Council Action:

Council created this GID in 1985 (Ordinance No. 85-112) and has performed annual financial actions as its board, since that time. The Board approved refinancing this GID's bonds in 2010 in the amount of \$3,900,000 (Ordinance No. 10-57). The Board annually (1) sets and certifies the mill levy, (2) adopts the budget, and (3) appropriates the funding for the District.

Background:

City Council sits as the Board of Directors for each of the General Improvement Districts and is required to conduct a public hearing, set and certify the mill levy, adopt an annual budget, and, appropriate the funding for the District.
