**Summary:**

The proposed resolution expresses City Council's continued appreciation for the work of the Council of Neighbors and Organizations (CONO) to support neighborhoods in the Pikes Peak region and its support for CONO's inaugural Neighbor Up! week, which will take place during the week of April 30-May 6, 2016.
