The medics from AMR commented that this patient was in such critical condition that the individual probably would have died had Josh not stepped up the way he did.

Chelsea Minnis was an extremely important part of this effort as well. Chelsea is a dispatcher with the Streets Division who stayed on the phone with Josh the entire time, giving him precise directions on the best and quickest way to get to the patient as well as getting to the hospital.
