Ordinance No. 17-22 amending Section 103 (Presiding Judge; Powers and Duties) of Article 2 (Judges) of Chapter 11 (Municipal Court) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as Amended, Pertaining to Judges

Summary:

During 2016, as part of the citywide “code scrub” effort to review City Code for necessary updates, members of City Council and representatives of the executive branch convened working committee to review the provisions of Chapter 1 (Administration) and certain provisions of other chapters that are administrative in nature. As a result of that review, the group recommends a number of changes to certain administrative provisions of City Code.

This ordinance amends Section 11.2.103 of Chapter 11 to clarify provisions relating to the duty of the Presiding Judge of Municipal Court to administer oaths to elected municipal officials and others as authorized by law.
