A Resolution Setting the Street Lighting Service Revenue Requirement for the Period of January 1, 2018 Through December 31, 2018

Summary:

Colorado Springs Utilities requests City Council to set the Street Lighting Revenue Requirement for the provision of street lighting services from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018 in the amount of four million, seventy-five thousand dollars (\$4,075,000).

Previous Council Action:

City Council set the Street Lighting Revenue Requirement for the period of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 with Resolution No. 121-16 dated November 8, 2016.

Background:

The street lighting infrastructure operated by Colorado Springs Utilities within the City of Colorado Springs (City) is part of the system of utilities owned and operated for the convenience and necessity of the citizens of the City. Section 12.9.103 of the City Code authorizes Colorado Springs Utilities to assess and collect a street lighting service charge from the Municipal Government of the City for the provision of street lighting services. Additionally, Section 12.9.105 of the City Code requires Colorado Springs Utilities to annually prepare a revenue requirement for the provision of street lighting service setting forth the amount that must be recovered for the provision of street lighting

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service pursuant to City Code Section 12.9.103.

Financial Implications:

Colorado Springs Utilities performed analysis of the Street Lighting Service Revenue Requirement and determined an amount of four million, seventy-five thousand dollars (\$4,075,000) required to recover expenditures for the provision of street lighting services from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.
