Resolution Directing the Chief Executive Officer of Colorado Springs Utilities to Execute a Regional Wastewater Service Agreement between Colorado Springs Utilities and the Rock Creek Metropolitan District

Summary:

Rock Creek Metropolitan District (RCMD) is requesting regional wastewater service from Colorado Springs Utilities. Colorado Springs Utilities is seeking City Council approval of resolutions authorizing its Chief Executive Officer to execute a regional Wastewater Service Agreement with RCMD.

Background:

RCMD's service area is located south of the City. RCMD is requesting regional wastewater service from Colorado Springs Utilities through a special contract with a twenty-five (25) year term to collect and treat up to 0.103 million gallons per day from RCMD's service. Regional contracts for wastewater service require prior approval from City Council as a condition of receiving service.

Previous Council Action:

Financial Implications:

Based on 2022 Tariffs, Colorado Springs Utilities would collect approximately \$150,000 per year at build out under both agreements.

City Council Appointed Board/Commission/Committee Recommendation:

Utilities Board recommended bringing the proposed Wastewater Service Agreement to City Council for consideration.

Stakeholder Process:

Utilities Board recommended bringing the proposed Wastewater Service Agreement to City Council for consideration.

Alternatives:

Approve the resolution authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to execute the Wastewater Service Agreement; (2) not approve the resolution; (3) modify the resolution or the Agreement; or (4) refer the matter back to Colorado Springs Utilities for further consideration.
