




Impact to Fund Balance



#### Sales Tax Trends



(economic activity thru June 2023)

#### 2.0% Sales and Use Tax:

- S&U combined down 1.63% for the month and up 0.01% year-to-date
  - Sales tax down 1.65% for the month and down 0.30% year-to-date
  - Use tax down 1.02% for the month and up 7.13% year-to-date

#### 2.0% Lodger's Tax & 1.0% Auto Rental Tax:

- LART Combined up 11.14% for the month and down 0.53% year-to-date
  - Lodger's Tax up 11.21% for the month and down 1.42% year-to-date
  - Auto Rental Tax up 10.12% for the month and up 10.62% year-to-date







#### **Index of Consumer Sentiment**






