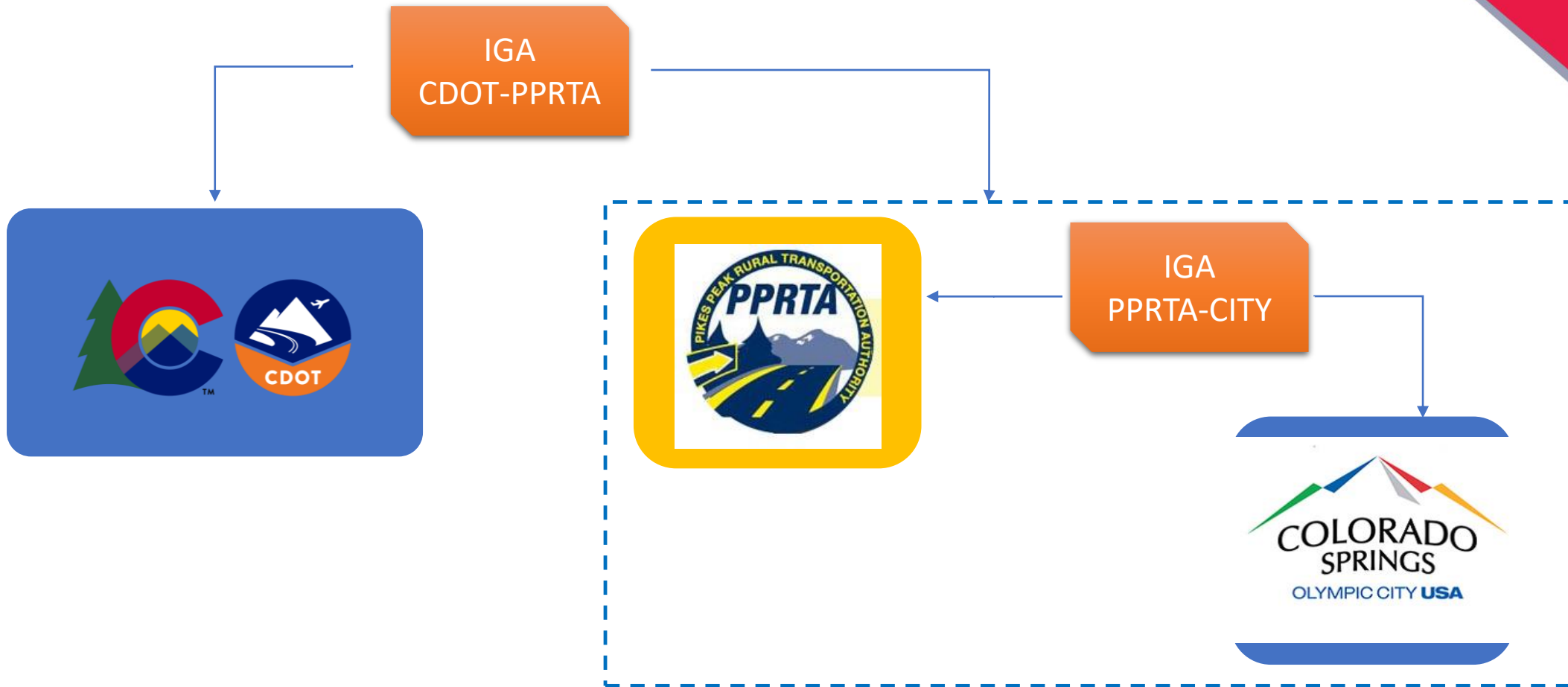

PURPOSE



- The PPRTA Board adopted Policy #31 authorizing PPRTA to apply for State grants on behalf of member governments
- PPRTA applied for State-funded MMOF grants for the benefit of the City of Colorado Springs
- PPRTA will enter into a contract with CDOT to receive the awarded funds
- In compliance with conditions of Policy #31, the City will manage, administer, and implement the grant/Project
- The IGA between PPRTA-City reinforces the conditions

- Approval authorizes Mayor to sign IGA with PPRTA
- PPRTA finalizes IGA with CDOT
 - City routinely enters into these CDOT IGAs directly
 - City has processes and knowledge to administer the grants

- City implements grant per the PPRTA-City IGA
