

ORDINANCE NO. 23 - 64

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 23-12, AND AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 14-20, (AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY AND SETTING THE SALARY OF THE CITY ATTORNEY), AND SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 18-120 (AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE CITY COUNCIL ADMINISTRATOR AND SETTING THE SALARY OF THE CITY COUNCIL ADMINISTRATOR), AND SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 21-06 (AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING JACQUELINE ROWLAND AS CITY AUDITOR AND PRESCRIBING HER DUTIES, COMPENSATION, AND TENURE IN OFFICE), AND PRESCRIBING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY ATTORNEY, CITY COUNCIL ADMINISTRATOR, AND CITY AUDITOR

WHEREAS, the salary ranges for the City Attorney, the City Council Administrator, and the City Auditor positions are included in the annual salary schedule which is approved by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, City Charter § 13-80 and City Code § 1.2.203 require the annual salary of the City Attorney be prescribed by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, City Charter § 3-10(e) requires the annual salary of the City Council Administrator be prescribed by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, City Charter § 3-10(e) and City Code § 1.2.203 require the annual salary of the City Auditor be prescribed by ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 23-12 is repealed.

Section 2. The salaries of the City Attorney, City Council Administrator, and City Auditor are prescribed as follows and effective as of December 24, 2023:

- A. City Attorney \$ 232,528
- B. City Council Administrator \$142,157
- C. City Auditor \$201,178

Section 3. Ordinance Nos. 14-20 (An Ordinance Confirming the Mayor's Appointment of the City Attorney and Setting the Salary of the City Attorney), 18-120 (An Ordinance Appointing the City Council Administrator and Setting the Salary of the City Council Administrator), and 21-06 (An Ordinance Appointing Jacqueline Rowland as City Auditor and Prescribing Her Duties, Compensation, and Tenure in Office) remain in full force and effect except to the extent they are inconsistent with the salaries prescribed by this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance supersedes all prior ordinances setting the salary of the City Attorney, City Council Administrator, and City Auditor to the extent such are inconsistent herewith.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 6. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
