AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 2 (USE AND OCCUPANCY OF PUBLIC PROPERTY) OF ARTICLE 2 (CITY PROPERTIES) OF CHAPTER 3 (PUBLIC PROPERTY AND PUBLIC WORKS) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO SIGN REGULATIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Part 2 (Use and Occupancy of Public Property) of Article 2 (City Properties) of Chapter 3 (Public Property and Public Works) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

2. Exceptions: The provision of subsection D.1 of this section shall not apply to any sign or signpost between the hours of ~~one minute after~~ twelve o'clock (12:00) P.M. on Friday through twelve o'clock (12:00) ~~P.M.~~ ~~noon~~ on **the following** Monday, provided that it is not placed upon any median, park property, ~~utility~~ies easement, or pole, but is placed within the public right of way and meets the following minimum standards:

a. The sign does not exceed six (6) square feet in area;

b. The sign is not placed within the ~~downtown core Form Based Zone District~~, as defined in **Chapter 7** subsection 7.4.1312 F2 of this Code; and

c. ~~The sign is not placed in the right of way adjacent to any residentially zoned property, unless express permission is granted by the property owner.~~

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this Ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this Ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
