A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SPRING CREEK TRIBUTARY OUTFALL

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs ("City") and the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement ("Agreement") to address the operation and maintenance of a City owned stormwater outfall on CDOT property; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is an intergovernmental agreement entered into pursuant to the Colorado Revised Statutes § 29-1-203, §43-1-110, et seq., 43-2-144 and 43-2-147, C.R.S., as amended; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement will benefit CDOT and the citizens of the City, providing for maintenance of infrastructure to route Spring Creek tributary flows in a safe and stable manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the Agreement between the City of Colorado Springs, Colorado, and the Colorado Department of Transportation, attached hereto as Exhibit A and hereby made a part of this resolution.

Section 2.	The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, administer, amend and renew
the Agreement.
