January 20, 2025

WHEREAS, on this day, we honor the life and legacy of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther

King, Jr., for his unwavering pursuit of equality, social justice, freedom, and service to all, becoming a symbol of hope and resilience in the

face of adversity; and

WHEREAS, his dream of a society where individuals are judged not by the color

of their skin but by the content of their character continues to inspire
