Subject Title: City Council Appointments and Reappointments to Boards, Commissions, and Committees

I. El Paso Teller County 911 Authority Board

Per the Bylaws of the El Paso-Teller County 9-1-1 Authority Board, multiple governing bodies appoint members to ensure regional representation in emergency communication services. City Council appoints three (3) members to represent the citizens of Colorado Springs. Following the retirement of Deputy Chief Dave Edmondson on February 21, 2025, Police Chief Adrian Vasquez nominated Deputy Chief John Koch to fill the vacancy. This nomination was reviewed by Councilmember Liaison Randy Helms.

II. Pikes Peak Regional Building Department (PPRBD) Overview of Appointment Authority

Per Section RBC111.5.1 of the Pikes Peak Regional Building Code, appointments to the Licensing Committee are made by the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County in conjunction with the City Council of Colorado Springs, acting as individual bodies but in agreement. Historically, the City and County have divided appointment responsibilities as follows:

- For the Licensing Committee, City Council appoints the Building Contractor A position.
- For the Technical Committee, City Council appoints the Building Contractor(s), the Engineer, the Architect, and the Electrical Contractor positions.

The reappointments for these positions were reviewed by Councilmember Liaison Brian Risley and qualified by Roger N. Lovell, Regional Building Official.

PPRBD Licensing Committee

The Licensing Committee is responsible for reviewing testing, experience, and licensing requirements, as well as addressing complaints filed against licensed or registered contractors.
