These additional costs will be expensed over a 10year period as they are incurred to help smooth the rate impact. With City Council approval, the proposed increase to the regulatory asset is \$3,000,000, for costs incurred in 2024 and continuing through 2025. If approved, this action will help smooth the rate impact of incurring the costs of Drake Decommissioning by amortizing those costs over a 10-Benefits: year period. I-3, Financial Planning and Budgeting. If approved, this will ensure that costs are shared between current and future customers. **Board Policy:** With City Council approval of the \$3,000,000 increase, Martin Drake Cost / Budget: Power Plant's regulatory asset will have a total value of \$23,525,070 and would increase the amortization period by one year to a total of 12 years. **Affected Parties:** N/A Without the increase to the existing regulatory asset, the annual expenses would be recorded against income in the year incurred and Alternatives: potentially drive short-term rate increases.
