ORDINANCE NO. 25-____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 101 (VEHICULAR TRAFFIC LIMITED) OF ARTICLE 27 (PARK TRAFFIC OFFENSES) OF CHAPTER 10 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) VEHICULAR TRAFFIC LIMITED OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO PARK TRAFFIC OFFENSES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 101 (Vehicular Traffic Limited) of Article 27 (Park Traffic Offenses) of Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

10.27.101: VEHICULAR TRAFFIC LIMITED:

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle, **motor vehicle**, **off-highway vehicle**, **snowmobile**, **farm tractor**, **golf cart**, **or toy vehicles**, on any area except nonservice paved park roads or nonservice improved dirt park roads or in park parking areas, or other areas as may be specifically designated as driving lanes or parking areas by the Park Manager.

Section 2. Any person convicted of a violation of Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, shall be punished as provided in Section 101 (Penalties) of Part 1 (General Provisions) of Article 1 (Administration and Enforcement) of Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
