



- Paid off \$7 million in short-term capital LOC.
- Paid off technology leases.
- Managed operations where revenues covered operating expenses.
- Restructured short-term debt to fixed-rate, long-term debt enhancing cash-flow position.







- Experienced a 55% increase in events from 162 events in 2021 to 232 in 2022. Forty of these special events were from out of state.
- The USOPM experienced an overall decline in attendance from 115,000 to just over 82,000 with 26,088 coming from Colorado.





- Museum has built monthly programming, focusing on ticket sales and membership.
- The most popular programming are athlete meet & greets. Other initiatives include things like: Health Care Week; Teacher Appreciation Weekend; First Responders Weekend; and more.
- Museum had multiple large-scale events.







- More than 1,294 students in 2022 and up to 1,350 students from El Paso County participated this past spring.




