## ORDINANCE NO. 24 - 19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 23-65 (2024 BUDGET APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE CONSERVATION TRUST FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$567,118 TO ADDRESS ADDITIONAL OPERATING AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 23-65 is hereby amended by increasing the Conservation Trust Fund expenditure appropriation in the amount of \$567,118, to address additional operating and capital needs, as follows:

- New mower for El Pomar Youth Sports Complex \$142,118
- Asbestos abatement at vacant structure in Palmer Park destroyed by fire in 2023 - \$100,000
- Portion of cost of construction of Grey Hawk Park \$325,000

The source of funds is unrestricted Conservation Trust Fund balance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
