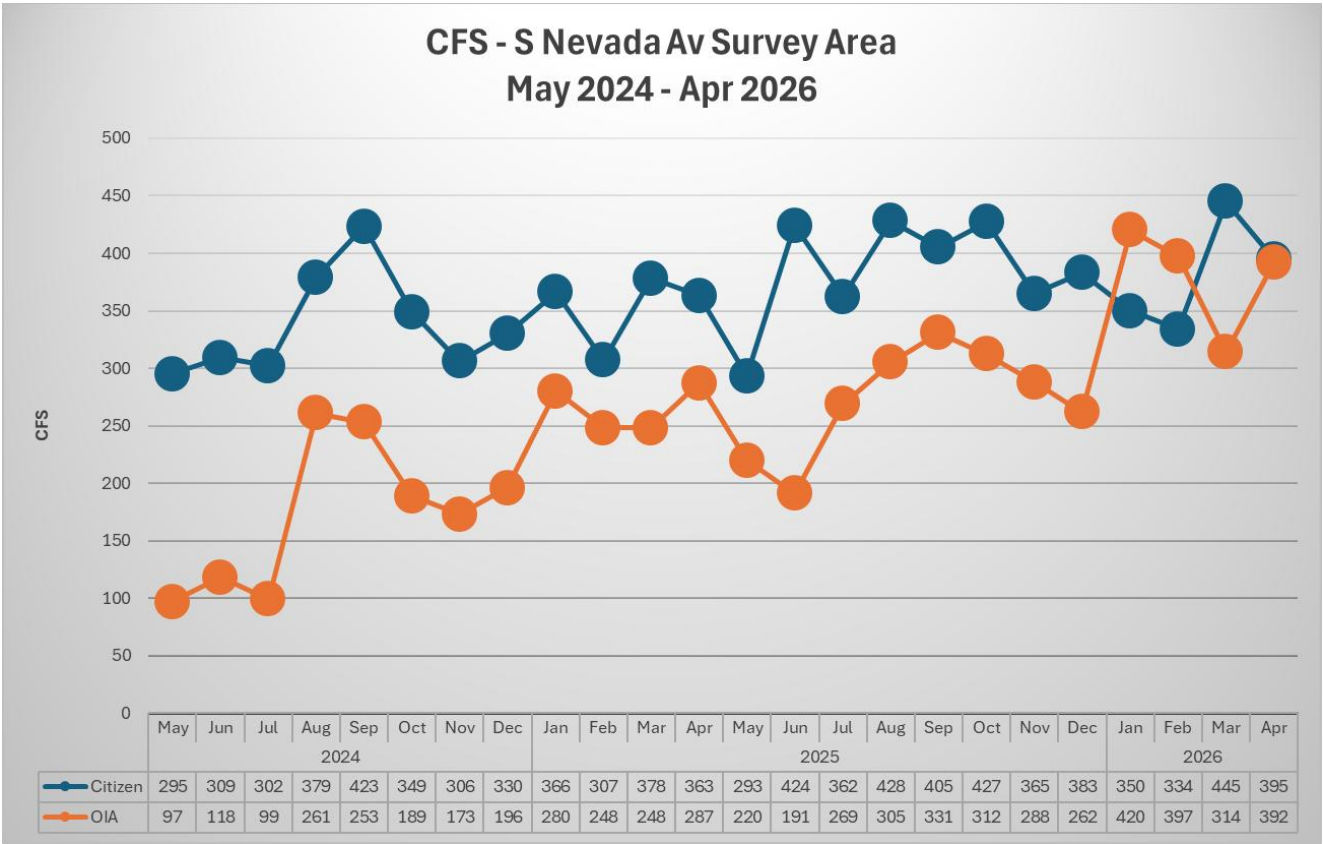
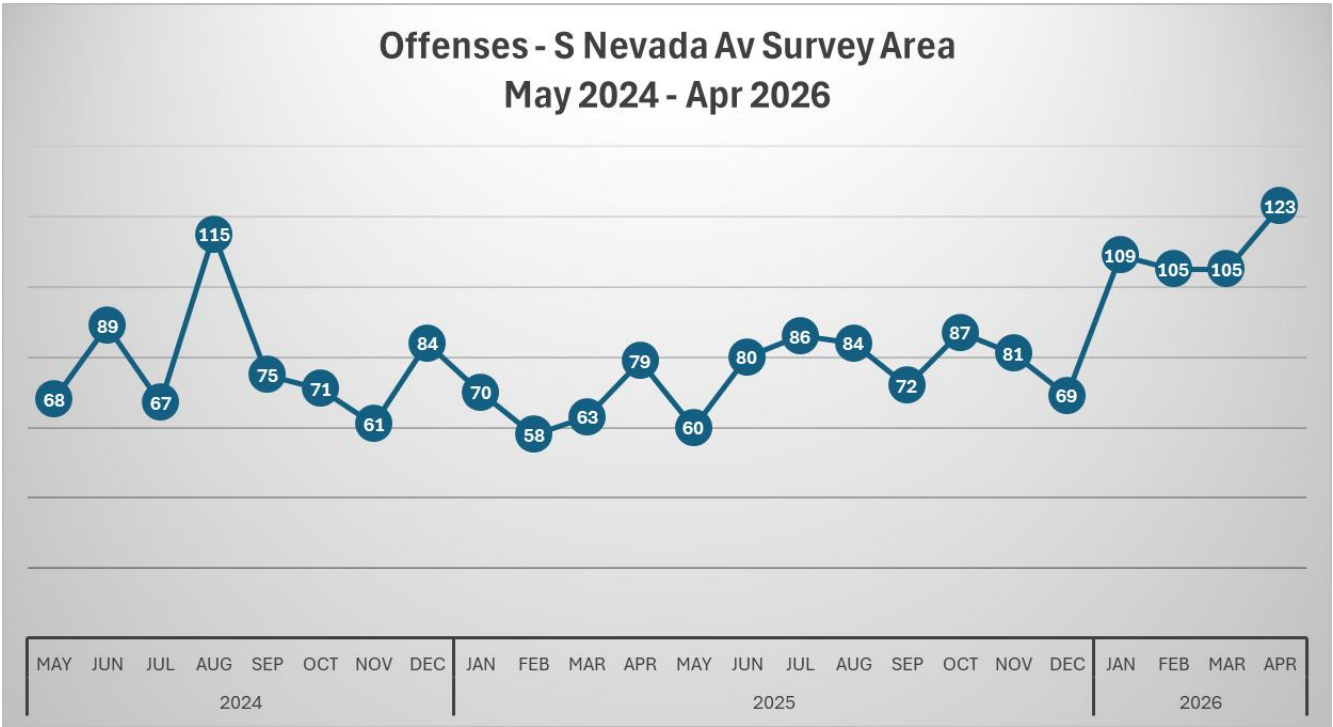


Calls For Service (CFS) - The chart below displays CFS volume by month for Citizen Generated and Officer Initiated (OIA) CFS. CFS data was obtained from the Corona-Discover system and CFS call types related to Unintentional/911 Hangups were omitted.



Offenses - The chart below displays Offense volume by month. Offense data was obtained from LERMS (submit offense=no and disposition=unfounded/non-criminal were omitted).



The table below displays the volume of Offenses by Type and Period (May 2024 – Apr 2025; May 2025 – Apr 2026). Please note, when examining percent change between time periods, Offense Types with low volume will have higher percent changes, however the actual aggregate change in volume is low.

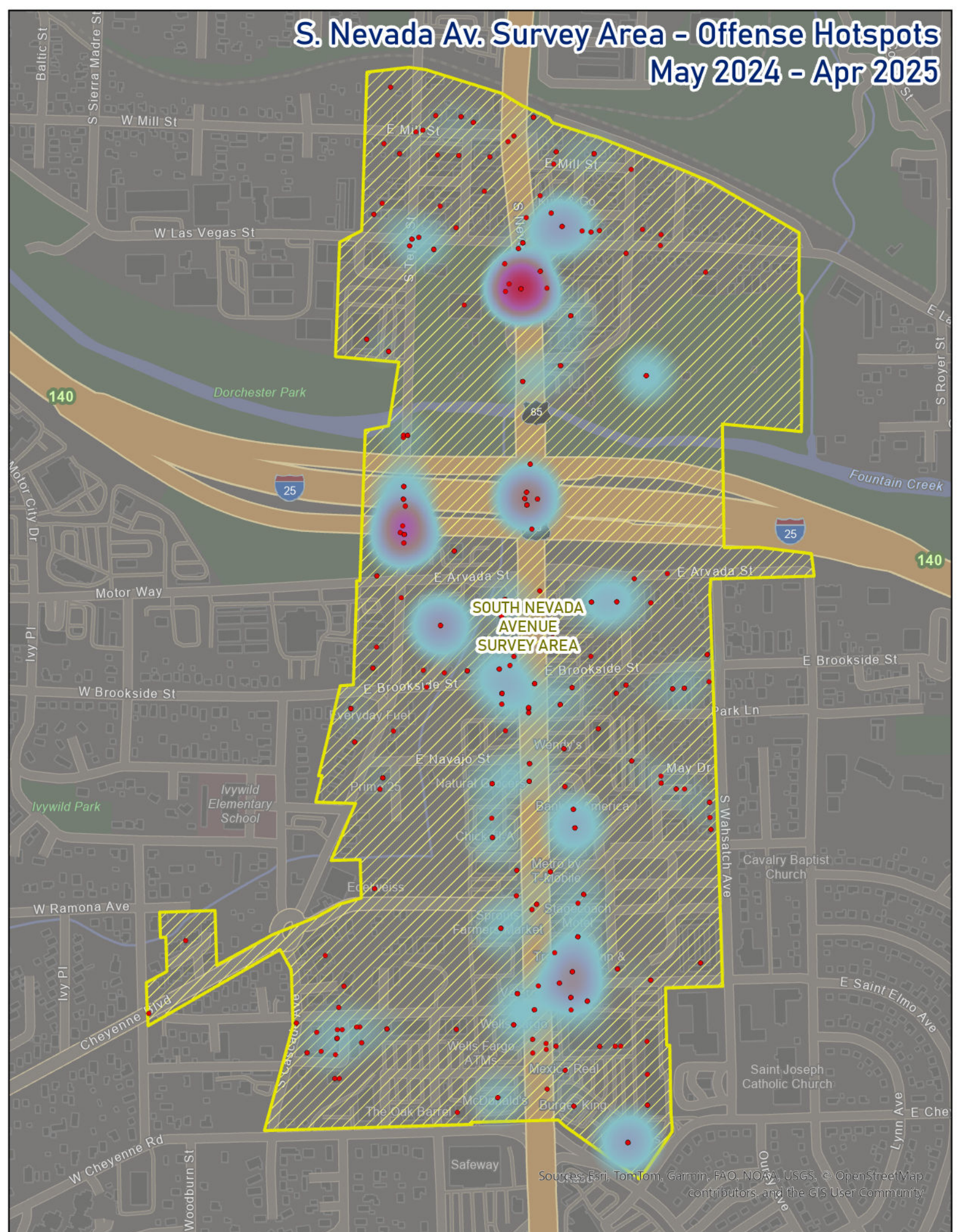
Analytical Summary

- For the date range examined, both Citizen Generated and Officer Initiated Activity (OIA) CFS volume are trending upward.
 - OIA CFS display a marked increase in 2026, likely related to the modifications made to the Peak Station units, indicating increased proactive efforts.
- When comparing the two time periods (May 2024 - Apr 2025 vs. May 2025 – Apr 2026) Offenses in this area have increased about 18%.
 - Select person crimes increased 13% (Agg Assault, Sex Crimes, Murder, Robbery, Simple Assault).
 - Select property crimes increased approximately 1% (Burglary, MVT, Theft from Motor Vehicle, Larceny).
 - A marked increase in the number of Trespass offenses occurred in the most recent time period (May 2025 – Apr 2026), indicating increased proactive efforts.
 - Indicators of disorder increased 40% (Larceny, All Other Offenses, Burglary, Vandalism, Simple Assault, Trespass).
 - Increased proactive efforts are likely a contributing factor to the increases in offenses.
- Offense hotspots remain relatively consistent over the time frame examined.
 - Areas of high offense density include Dorchester Park, the I-25 & Tejon/Nevada complex, and S. Nevada corridor.

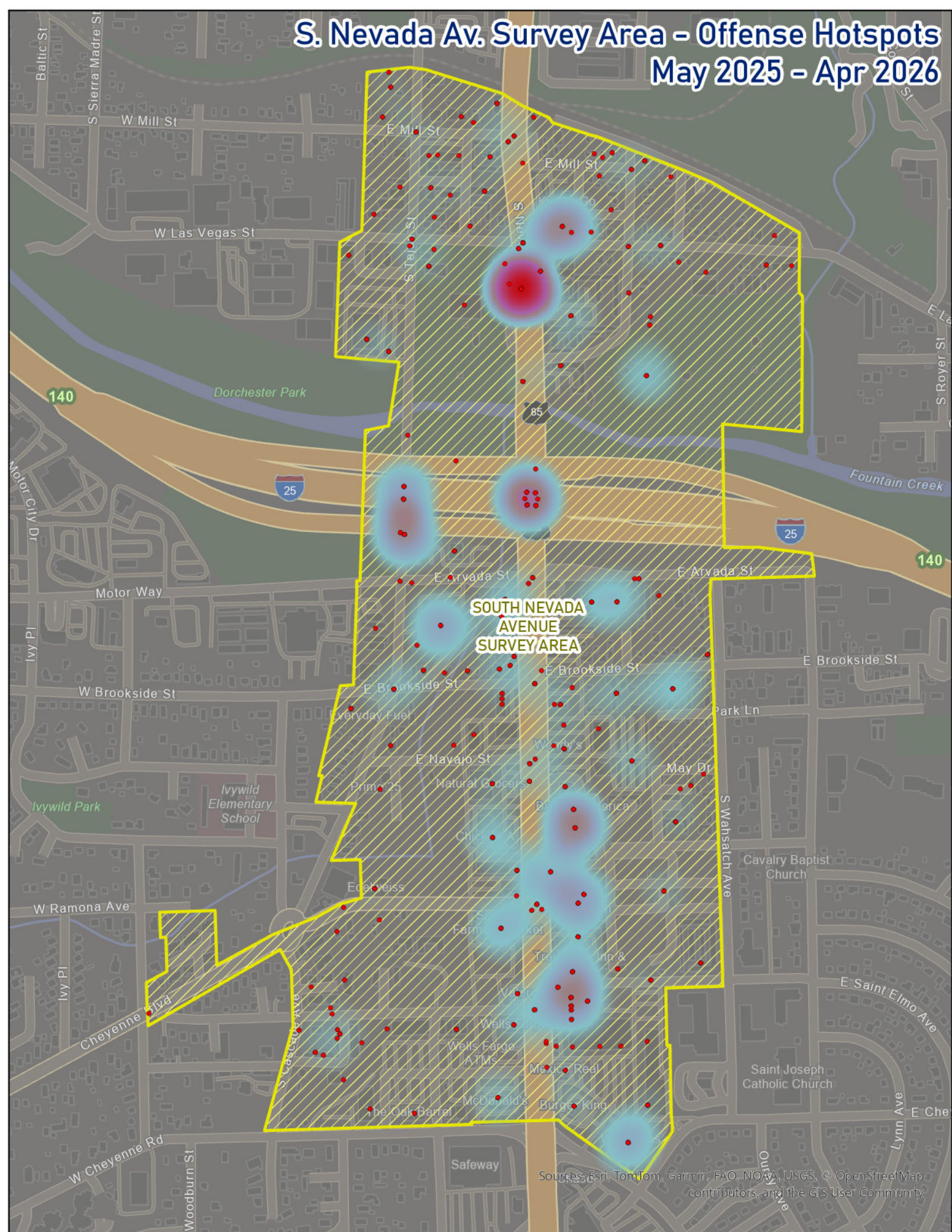
