AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 409 (APPOINT HEARING OFFICERS) OF PART 4 (POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE CITY ATTORNEY) OF ARTICLE 2 (OFFICERS OF THE CITY) OF CHAPTER 1 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND FINANCE) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO APPOINTMENT OF HEARING OFFICERS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 409 (Appoint Hearing Officers) of Part 4 (Powers And Duties Of The City Attorney) of Article 2 (Officers Of The City) of Chapter 1 (Administration, Personnel, And Finance) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

1.2.409: APPOINT HEARING OFFICERS:

The City Attorney shall appoint Hearing Officers to resolve disputes as otherwise authorized in this Code or in the tariffs of the Utilities, **and for any other reason required or permitted by law.**

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
