As Chair and on behalf of the Colorado Springs Fire Board of Appeals, I would like to extend the Board's support and recommendation for adoption of the proposed 2026 update to Appendix K of the Fire Code. This important update integrates the Colorado State Wildfire Resiliency Code, with important local amendments, into the Fire Prevention Code.

The Colorado Springs Fire Department has provided the board with regular updates regarding the development of the Colorado State Wildfire Resiliency Code.
