A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON STATE HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs (“City”) and the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) desire to enter into a contract (“Agreement”) to address the operation and maintenance of CDOT owned traffic signals on State highways within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is an intergovernmental agreement entered into pursuant to the Colorado Revised Statutes § 29-1-203; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement will benefit CDOT and the citizens of the City, providing consistency and timeliness in addressing service calls, emergency after hour calls, and traffic signal timing changes regardless of ownership of the roadways; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement allows for consistency in signal timing and operations along corridors that cross jurisdictional boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the intergovernmental agreement between the City of Colorado Springs, Colorado, and the Colorado Department of Transportation, attached hereto as Exhibit A and hereby made a part of this resolution.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, administer, amend and renew the Agreement.
