A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE STORMWATER ENTERPRISE
MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENTS WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION RELATED TO MAINTENANCE OF
STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE

WHEREAS, City Code § 14.8.104 grants the Stormwater Enterprise Manager (SE Manager) the power to execute all contracts and agreements in the name of the City of Colorado Springs ("City"), except that contracts and agreements between the enterprise and other Colorado or Federal governmental entities (intergovernmental agreements) shall be subject to the approval of City Council; and

WHEREAS, City Code § 14.8.102 requires the Stormwater Enterprise to provide maintenance activities for the City owned stormwater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") periodically cooperates with the City to construct stormwater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, CDOT's Maintenance Agreements take the form of intergovernmental agreements ("IGAs"); and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statute § 29-1-203 permits IGAs only if such cooperation or contracts are authorized by each party thereto with the approval of its legislative body or other authority having the power to so approve.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS THAT:

Section 1. City Council hereby authorizes the SE Manager to enter into intergovernmental agreements related to maintenance of stormwater infrastructure with CDOT.
