AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 25-95 (2026 BUDGET APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE RETAIL MARIJUANA TAX FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$458,000 TO FUND A CONTRACT WITH THE COLORADO SPRINGS URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SECURITY SERVICES IN THE SOUTH NEVADA CORRIDOR

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Budget Ordinance No. 25-95 is hereby amended by increasing the expenditure appropriation of the Retail Marijuana Tax Fund in the amount of \$458,000 to fund a contract with the Colorado Springs Urban Renewal Authority to provide security services in the South Nevada corridor. The full contract cost is \$758,000, which will be covered by \$300,000 already appropriated and the additional \$458,000 provided through this budget amendment. The source of funds is the available fund balance in the Retail Marijuana Tax Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
