SUMMARY



City Responsibilities

- Perform annual inspections
- Respond to emergency calls
- Conduct as needed repairs
- Set and modify signal timing

El Paso County Responsibilities

- Provide annual payment to cover time and material of city responsibilities
- Provide one-time payment for signal upgrades

BACKGROUND



- 55 County-owned signals
- Greater responsiveness to service calls, after hour calls, and signal timing changes
- Consistency in signal timing across corridors region wide
- One point of contact to report signal issues
- Consistency in preventative maintenance and equipment region wide
- City currently has similar agreement with CDOT (76 signals)

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS



- Annual payment for scope of services
 - Covers material costs
 - Two additional signal maintenance staff members
 - Adjusted annually
- One-time payment
 - Upgrade equipment
 - Compatibility with the City of Colorado Springs' system
