A RESOLUTION APPROVING  
THE AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND EL PASO  
COUNTY, COLORADO ESTABLISHING THE PIKES PEAK  
REGIONAL OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the City and the County consolidated their respective Offices of Emergency Management to create the Pikes Peak Regional Office of Emergency Management (“PPROEM”) on January 22, 2019 for the purpose of establishing an interjurisdictional disaster agency to serve the people of the County and the City in the event of a natural or human- caused disaster, and

WHEREAS, the original Intergovernmental Agreement, effective January 22, 2019, was continued for an additional three-year term by City Resolution on March 14, 2023, and

WHEREAS, the amended Agreement incorporates updated terminology, governance structure, and operational practices to maintain efficient regionalized emergency management functions, and

WHEREAS, the City is seeking to continue the PPROEM intergovernmental agreement with El Paso County for another three (3) year period to maintain current regionalized emergency management functions, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”

Section 2. The City Council further authorizes the Mayor of the City of Colorado Springs to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City.
