

**A RESOLUTION FIXING AND CERTIFYING THE 2025
ANNUAL ASSESSMENT MILL LEVY FOR ASSESSMENTS
PAYABLE IN 2026 AT 3.615 MILLS UPON EACH DOLLAR
OF ASSESSED VALUATION WITHIN THE WOODSTONE
SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT MAINTENANCE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 3-7-108 of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, City Council shall fix a rate of assessment within the district and shall raise the amount required by the district during the ensuing fiscal year to meet the cost of maintaining and securing the public improvements included in the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That the City Council determines the amount of money to be raised by the assessment mill levy for the Woodstone Special Improvement Maintenance District (District) for the ensuing year is the sum of \$29,269.

Section 2. That for the purpose of maintaining and securing the public improvements included in the District, an assessment mill levy for the Year 2025, to be collected in the same manner as a tax levy, shall be fixed at 3.615 mills upon each dollar of assessed valuation of property within the District for collection in 2026.

Section 3. That the City is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of El Paso County Commissioners in accordance with Section 3-7-108 of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended.
