- New mower for El Pomar Youth Sports Complex \$142,118
- Asbestos abatement at vacant structure in Palmer Park destroyed by fire in 2023 \$100,000
- Portion of cost of construction of Grey Hawk Park \$325,000

The source of funds is unrestricted Conservation Trust Fund balance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its

final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.
